

# Troubleshooting „Activate PDF Plug-in in Browser“

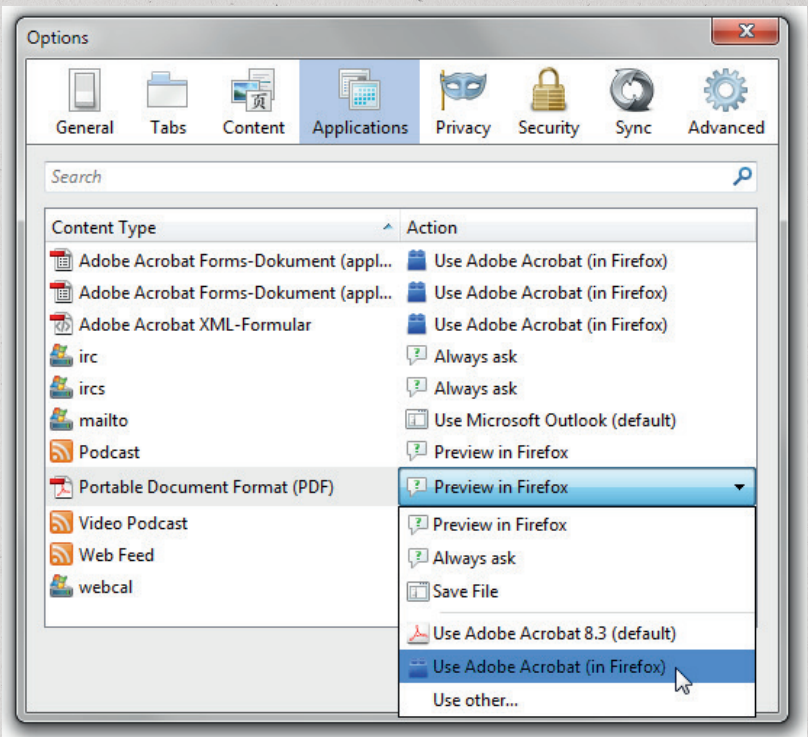
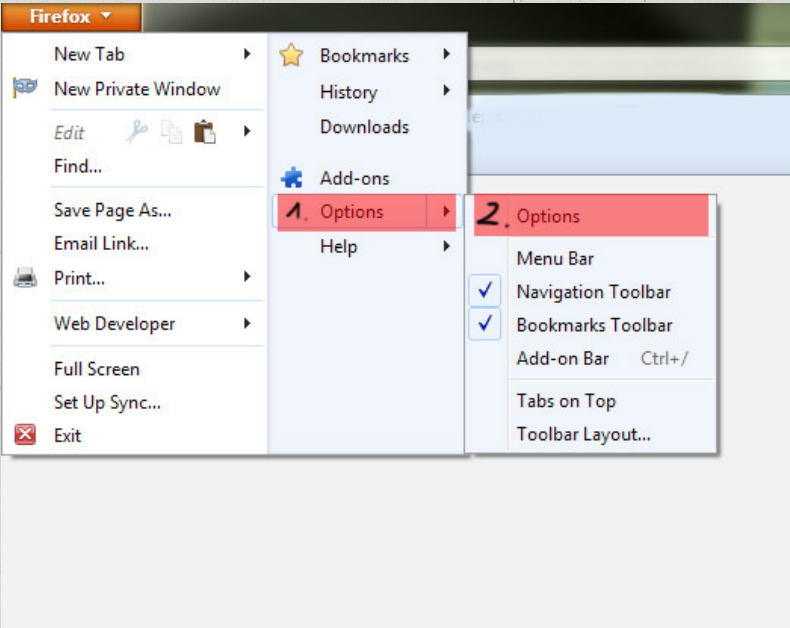
## FIREFOX BROWSER

### USING A PDF READER PLUGIN

In case of problems using the built-in Firefox PDF Viewer, you can use a PDF reader plugin like Adobe Reader, Nitro PDF Reader or Sumatra PDF.

To change from using the built-in PDF viewer to your PDF reader plugin:

1. At the top of the Firefox window, click on the **Firefox** button and then select Options
2. Select the **Applications** panel.
3. Find **Portable Document Format (PDF)** in the list and click on it to select it.
4. Click on the drop-down arrow in the **Action** column for the above entry and select **Use PDF reader name (in Firefox)**.



### CHECK APPLICATION SETTINGS

If the PDF reader plugin comes bundled with a reader application, check the application plugin setting if there is some.

#### Adobe Reader:

1. Open Adobe Reader.
2. Once in Adobe Reader, click the Edit menu in the menu bar, and then click Preferences.... The Preferences window will open.
3. In the Categories section, click on Internet.
4. Make sure the first check box, Display PDF in browser, is checked.
5. Click OK to dismiss the Preferences window, and then close Adobe Reader.

### LAST ALTERNATIVE

1. Open windows explorer
2. Open your CD drive
3. Search „PBC\_toolbox.pdf“ and just double click.

Your PDF Reader of choice should open the file now.

If you don't have a PDF reader installed on your system **please install** that one placed in the AdobeAcrobatReader directory on the toolbox CD.

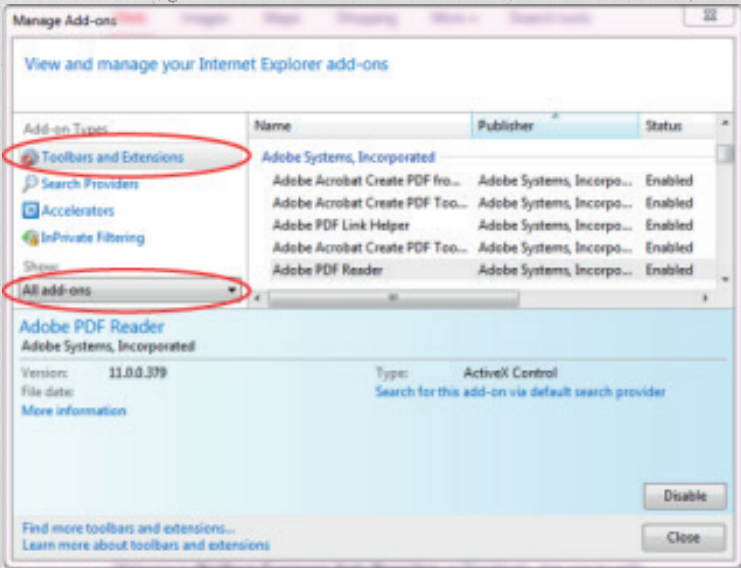


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## INTERNET EXPLORER 8 and 9

Internet Explorer 8 and 9

1. Open Internet Explorer, and choose Tools > Manage Add-ons.
2. Under Add-on Types, select Toolbars And Extensions.
3. In the Show menu, select All Add-ons.



Select All Add-ons from the Show menu in the Manage Add-ons dialog box.

4. In the list of add-ons, select Adobe PDF Reader.

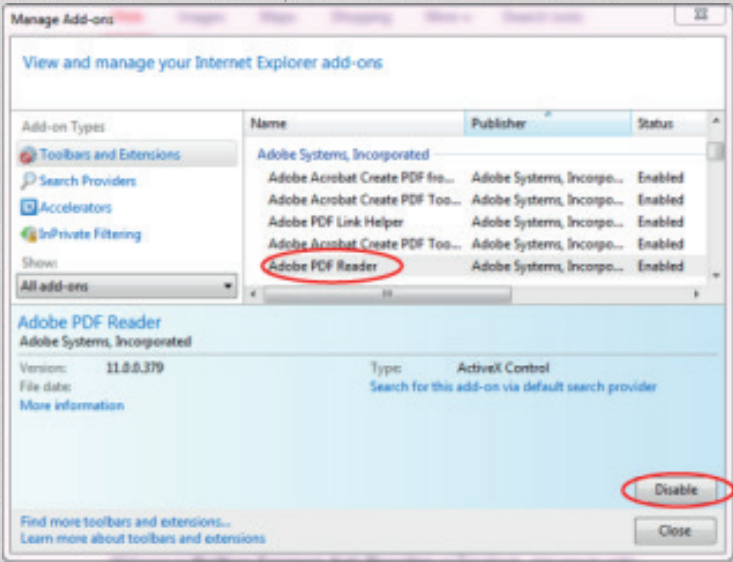
**Note:**

If you do not see the Adobe PDF Reader add-on, try the other options on the menu. For example, on some systems, the add-on appears when you select Run Without Permission.

5. Click the Enable or Disable button (it toggles depending on the status of the selected add-on):

**Enable** sets the Adobe PDF Reader add-on to open PDFs in the browser.

**Disable** turns off the add-on so it does not open PDFs in the browser.



Select Adobe PDF Reader, and click the Enable/Disable button.

### LAST ALTERNATIVE

1. Open windows explorer
2. Open your CD drive
3. Search „PBC\_toolbox.pdf“ and just double click.

Your PDF Reader of choice should open the file now.

If you don’t have a PDF reader installed on your system **please install** that one placed in the AdobeAcrobatReader directory on the toolbox CD.
